Art and Design / Design Technology


In art and design, we will be looking at the work of Henri Rousseau.

Numeracy

Across the summer term, we will be looking at decimals, money, the area of figures, geometry, position and movement and exploring mass, volume and length.

Music

We will be looking at composing music, singing and performing, using the song Blackbird by the Beatles.

French

Creative : History / Geography

In History, we will continue to explore the Roman legacy linking this to our home, in Lancaster.

In Geography, we will use Digimaps to develop our mapping skills and carry out fieldwork on the Lake District, linked to our school visit. We will also compare our learning of the Lake District to the French Alps.

Computing

The children will be using the ipads and laptops for research, continued coding activities and times table knowledge.

Science

We will look at the unit 'electricity'. The children will learn how to construct a simple series electrical circuit and identify and name its various parts. We will also investigate common conductors and insulators. After half term we will look at 'living things and their habitats' and explore how changes to the environment can sometimes pose dangers to living things.
