School Performance 2017-2018

The end of Key Stage 2 Statutory Attainment Tests (SATs) taken by the Year 6 pupils in May 2018 provide the following information on attainment and progress for our school.

The percentage of pupils who achieved the expected standard of attainment at the end of Key Stage 2.

Reading	97%	(National Average 75%)
Writing	97%	(National Average 78%)
Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling	97%	(National Average 77%)
Mathematics	97%	(National Average 75%)
Reading/Writing/Mathematics combined	93%	(National Average 64%)

The percentage of pupils who achieved a higher standard of attainment at the end of Key Stage 2.

Reading	60%	(National Average 28%)
Writing	40%	(National Average 20%)
Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling	83%	(National Average 34%)
Mathematics	57%	(National Average 24%)
Reading/Writing/Mathematics combined	33%	(National Average 10%)

The average progress of pupils at the end of Key Stage 2

Reading	3.0	(significantly better than the national average)
Writing	1.4	(not significantly different from the national average)
Mathematics	3.7	(significantly better than the national average)

The average scaled score of pupils in the tests at the end of Key Stage 2

Reading	111	(National Average 105)
Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling	114	(National Average 106)
Mathematics	111	(National Average 104)
