School Performance 2019

The end of Key Stage 2 Statutory Attainment Tests (SATs) taken by the Year 6 pupils in May 2019 provide the following information on attainment and progress for our school.

The percentage of pupils who achieved the expected standard of attainment at the end of Key Stage 2.

Reading	97%	(National Average 73%)
Writing	91%	(National Average 78%)
Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling	100%	(National Average 78%)
Mathematics	100%	(National Average 79%)
Reading/Writing/Mathematics combined	88%	(National Average 65%)

The percentage of pupils who achieved a higher standard of attainment at the end of Key Stage 2.

Reading	42%	(National Average 27%)
Writing	49%	(National Average 20%)
Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling	73%	(National Average 36%)
Mathematics	42%	(National Average 27%)
Reading/Writing/Mathematics combined	30%	(National Average 11%)

The average progress of pupils at the end of Key Stage 2

Reading	1.9	(not significantly different than the national average)
Writing	1.4	(not significantly different from the national average)
Mathematics	2.4	(better than the national average)

The average scaled score of pupils in the tests at the end of Key Stage 2

Reading	109	(National Average 104)
Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling	113	(National Average 106)
Mathematics	110	(National Average 105)
